Reserve “Class B” Fermented Malt Beverage (Beer) License and Class “B” Liquor License Expiring June 30, 2011 - Cancun Bay, Ltd. – Jesus Gonzalez Hidalgo for Cancun Mexican Restaurant at 1422 Superior Avenue, Tomah, WI. The Cancun Mexican Restaurant is eligible for the reserve license that was relinquished by Mr. Murphy of Dimensions at the January Council meeting. The Cancun Mexican Restaurant is scheduled to open on January 17, 2011 and all inspections have been completed.
